

## RIDE CLASS:

- D - Slow to Leisurely:** 10-12 mph - Good for families with children over 12 or as introductory ride. Regroups as necessary; waits for slower riders; no one gets dropped.
- C - Moderate:** 12-15 mph - Beginning to good riders. Regroups every 5 to 8 miles; waits for slower riders; no one gets dropped.
- B - Brisk:** 16-20 mph - Experienced riders. Regroups every 10 to 12 miles; may require paceline riding; waits for slower riders.
- A - Fast:** 21+ mph - Strong to very strong riders. Requires paceline riding; may regroup every 15 to 20 miles; but no obligation to wait. \*Pace rating are based on level ground, non-paceline speeds. Actual speeds may vary up or down due to terrain and weather conditions.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- ♦ Rides leave promptly at the times listed. Arrive 5-10 minutes early.
- ♦ Helmets are required on all rides.
- ♦ All rides will start as scheduled, weather permitting.
- ♦ The starting times and distances on each ride allow different levels of riders to arrive at the destination at approximately the same time.
